- There is a \$40 service charge for all returned checks. Only cash, money order or cashiers check are accepted on arrival day.

Camp Tuition covers all of the camp programs, instructional activities and camp shirts. Each camper will receive 1 uniform shirt, tie (first year only) and camp t-shirt. Spending money is suggested for campers (to cover **extra** laundry and incidentals) and will be deposited into their personal account.

Cancellation and Refunds: A non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 should accompany each application to be credited to one's account. Any cancellation before March 1 will incur a \$100 processing fee and remainder will be refunded. No refunds for late arrival or early departure. No refunds for dismissal from camp due to homesickness, emotional and/or behavioral issues. Should a camper need to withdraw for health reasons anytime after March 1, we will give full credit toward next summer's registration. There are **NO REFUNDS** given after April 1.

Sibling Discount: When 2 or more children living at the same address - tuition fees will be reduced by 5%.

Referral Bonus: Earn \$50 off camp fee for every new two-week camper referred and earn \$25 for every new one week camper.

Communication: For speed and efficiency, Camp Dixie will communicate through email. Please make sure we have an accurate email address on file for you, and that you check it regularly. We respect your privacy and will not share your email address with other businesses.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES

The Standards of Dixie have always been very high. The director reserves the right to request parents to withdraw their children from camp if they do not measure up to the camp standards or if their presence in camp is considered inimical to the welfare of their associates. This policy is frankly and clearly stated so that all may understand it before seeking admission to Dixie. In this way discriminating parents may not feel any hesitance in enrolling their children. Before campers are enrolled, they are carefully screened to assure a wholesome and harmonious camping experience for all.

Policies:

The Dixie Camps have many policies in effect which come from years of experience in working with boys and girls. They are planned so that each camper may derive the maximum from his or her camping experience. Our standards are high and we will continue to keep them that way so that parents are assured of the best care and individual attention for their children. We therefore ask all parents of Dixie campers to abide by the rules and policies. In this way no camper will feel that he or she is being denied privileges or granted privileges.

One week:

Is designed to introduce children to the magical world of camping. Campers receive daily instruction in activities they choose, geared to their abilities as well as participate in special events.

Two weeks (must be back to back):

Is a program filled with excitement and fun for children ages 6 to 16. Campers receive daily instruction in activities they choose, geared to their abilities as well as participate in special events.

Four weeks:

Gives campers the opportunity to experience the joys of camping and a chance to grow mentally, physically and socially.

Full Season:

Offers each camper a summer of fun and an opportunity to enjoy camp life to its fullest.

Laundry:

Laundry is done once a week for those who are enrolled for two weeks or more. Laundry for campers who soil their clothes and/or bedding is provided at an additional fee (\$15).

Packages:

Packages containing food or candy are not allowed. Chewing gum is not permitted, please do not send it.

Leadership Training:

Those campers who have completed their freshman or sophomore year in high school may qualify to take part in the Counselor Training Program. This program is designed to give young people valuable training in leadership and practical experience commensurate to their age. Full details will be sent upon request.

Spending Money:

Campers should not have extra money in their possession during camp. All money should be deposited in the camp office. The staff determines how much spending money is needed for special trips and will issue these "spending money" amounts when necessary. If you desire your child to have extra money on hand, please send it to the Director and not to the child.

Telephone calls: Cell phones are not allowed.

Campers are not allowed to make or receive telephone calls. In case of an emergency the camp office will notify parents. Parents may call the director if a problem arises. Letters and cards should be used for communications, birthdays, and other special occasions.

Transportation:

Parents who choose to have their child arrive by plane pay a transportation fee. Children are required to be at camp a day early and are billed for that day.

Visitation:

Only campers staying longer than 2 consecutive weeks may have visitors during the designated visiting period because it disrupts the camp program. The visiting period is after the first two weeks. These campers may leave camp during that period with visitors if they have written permission from home.

What Not to Bring:

Cash, cell phones, food or gum, fans, computers, DVD players are not permitted. No devices with video playback capability.
